Dear Fairview Families,

What a wonderful first three days of school! I know I can easily speak for all Fairview Staff when I say how wonderful it was to welcome our children back to the building this week!

I wanted to take a moment to share a few reminders regarding morning arrival at Fairview. Students will be welcomed into the building beginning at 8:10 each morning. Students arriving via car should be dropped off at the **side parking lot** and walkers and bus riders may enter through the front doors. Please do not drop off students prior to 8:10 a.m., as supervision is not available until this time. Please do not drop students off in the bus circle or in the front parking lot as walking between cars and crossing where the busses travel is dangerous due to obstructed visibility.

As we move into our second week, students are to transition to classrooms independently. Beginning Tuesday, September 8, staff will be available to assist students who may need a helping hand to their classrooms. We kindly ask that families plan to say goodbye at the front doors if entering the building. Fairview will continue providing superior customer service to all families and provide extra support to students each morning.

We are committed to the safety and supervision of all students and we appreciate your help with adhering to our Visitor Policy and Morning Protocol. Our purpose in implementing this policy is not to keep families out of our building, but rather to keep our students safe. I realize that it may be difficult to send your little one independently to class, but please rest assured that staff is posted at the front and throughout the building to assist your child to class safely and comfortably.

Due to the natural hustle and bustle of the morning, it will not be possible to meet with teachers during arrival unless a previously scheduled meeting has been set. Teachers can be reached to set up an appointment at your convenience by email or by calling before or after school.

We appreciate your continued partnership with our teachers and staff and thank you in advance for assisting us with the implementation of our safety procedures. Should you have any questions or have other ideas as to how we can make our building processes run smoother, please don't hesitate to give me a call.

Our goal this year is to ensure that every student attends school regularly. Positive attendance is a key ingredient to keeping kids on track academically and in engaging them in all aspects of school life.

Showing up for school has a huge impact on a student's academic success starting in kindergarten and continuing through high school. Even as children grow older and more independent, families play a key role in making sure students get to school safely every day and understand why attendance is so important for success in school and in life.

We realize some absences are unavoidable due to health problems or other circumstances. But, we also know that when students miss too much school— regardless of the reason – it can cause them to fall behind academically.
